



## Nursery News – Autumn 2020

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to welcome you to All Saints Nursery and hope everyone had a wonderful summer! We are so proud of the children at how well they have settled so far.

You will receive a letter like this at the start of each half term and it will contain all the information for what is happening in Nursery.

This half term:

- PE will be on Thursdays and will begin after half term once all the children are settled. Please make sure your child has their PE bag
- Our visit to the library will be on Tuesdays where the children will have an opportunity to go and choose two books which they can take home for a week. Please return your child's books the following Tuesday. Library will also begin after half term
- We would like to ask for a voluntary contribution of £5.00 per term for Arts and Crafts and various other creative activities. As mentioned, this is a voluntary contribution and

would not affect your child's involvement in such activities. This year payments will be via the school money app. You will receive a welcome message once the payment has been set up by the office. This welcome message will give you your log on details and advise you to set a password.

- Drop off will take place from the side car park area. The gate will open at **8.40am** for siblings to enter Nursery and will be open until **9am**.
- Pick up- please ensure you pick your child up by **12:20pm** as the gate will need to be locked for Reception children who will have their lunchtime play in the Nursery playground following their lunch
- Topic this half term will be "Marvellous Me". Children will be able to share information about themselves such as their favourite things to do at home, talking about their family and much more

Just a few reminders about procedures:

- We like to celebrate the children's independent achievements away from the setting, these are called 'Wow Moments'. For example: trying new food, getting themselves dressed or learning to ride a bike. I am attaching the Wow Moments template for your use.

- Please ensure your child has a bag of spare school clothes in their PE bag on their peg
- Please ensure all clothing is clearly labelled

You will have regular opportunities to meet members of our team during the year to discuss your child. These will range from formal
