




Victorious Vikings

You can show this in any way you choose.</p>	<p>We are looking at electricity in science this term. Draw a table to show the different ways that you have used electricity this week. Decide if it was an 'essential' use - cooking or a 'non-essential' use - watching T.V. You many need to give a reason for your answer.</p>
