Happy New Year! Thank you for your lovely Christmas gifts and wishes. Below is an outline of Year 6 learning for the first spring half-term:

Topic Title	WW2
English	<b>Goodnight Mister Tom-</b> Drama work re-enacting the story and analysing characters. Diary entries, information report on evacuation, narratives based on evacuation, letter persuading Willie to stay with Tom, newspaper report on Willie's baby sister, article for a younger audience about rationing – explanation of what it was, information about it; instructions how to make a cake without sugar.
Mathematics	<b>Decimals and Percentages:</b> Place value knowledge to three decimal places; multiply by 10, 100 and 1,000; divide by 10, 100 and 1,000; multiply decimals by integers; divide decimals by integers; division to solve problems; decimals as fractions; fractions to decimals; fractions to percentages; equivalent FDP; order FDP; percentage of an amount; percentages – missing values.
Science	<b>Light</b> Investigating how light travels, investigating how light can be bent and reflected, and exploring how white light can be split up and refraction.
Computing	Spreadsheet Modelling/ How can we trust the internet? / Collecting, analysing, evaluating and presenting data and information from the internet
RE	Buddhism
Geography/History	WW2: Where and how it began, evacuation, rationing, The Blitz, conscription, role of women
PE	Cricket and Gymnastics
DT/Art	Year Six war time bake off project
PSHE	Emotional Health and Wellbeing <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Drug education</li></ul> Relationships <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Arguments and families</li><li>• Strong emotions</li></ul>
