Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you all had a lovely half term break; we are looking forwards to another fun half term with Nursery! During these last few weeks in Nursery, will be doing lots of things to get your child ready for Reception.

This half term:

- From Monday 13th June, we will be **meeting the children at the gate at 9am**, so please be prepared to say goodbye to them there. Please arrive at 9am so we can start our day on time.
- **Collection will be from the classroom door**, so children will need to bring their belongings out to you.
- We understand that some children have a comforter toy at school. As part of the transition, this will need to be kept in their bag or with the teacher.
- We will be spending more time in the Reception classroom, either with the Reception class or when they are elsewhere.
- As the weather is becoming hot and sunny, please provide a **sunhat** for your child and apply **sunscreen** before school. Please make sure your child has a school **sweatshirt** at school even on hot mornings, as it can get a bit chilly at times.
- We would like to ask for a voluntary contribution of £5.00 per half term for Arts and Crafts and various other creative activities. As mentioned, this is a voluntary contribution and would not affect your child's involvement in such activities. Please can this be paid via the school money app.

What we will be learning:

- We will be focusing on how to look after our teeth and why this is important. If any family members are dentists or work in a dental surgery, we would love to invite you in to talk to us about your job and/or answer some of the children's questions.
- We are learning 2 new songs for the Music Festival (see dates below).
- To prepare for Sports day, we will be trying out the different events in our mini PE lessons.
