You can design your own or copy this pattern into your books. Make it lovely and colourful for our display.</p>	<p>In Anglo Saxon times the map of the UK looked very different. Research the way our country looked between 449-1066. Display your findings in any way you choose.</p>	<p>In Science we are investigating about how sounds are made. Take a walk around your home and note down the sounds you can hear in each room. *which room was the noisiest? *which room had the most sounds? *where was the quietest place in your house? *Did the time of day make a difference?</p>
<p>Write a poem of at least 4 verses about this time of year. It could be about Autumn, going back to school, the change in the weather, Harvest or something else. You can include a picture if you wish.</p>	<p>Anglo Saxons lived in Long houses. Make a model of a traditional long house. Record in your homework book how you made it.</p> <p style="color: red;">You can take two weeks to make this.</p>	<p>October is Black History month. Research a black scientist and explain what they were famous for. Do you think they were given the praise they deserved for their discovery/work? If not, why not?</p>	<p>Think about different words that are linked to sound. Can you create a game using these words. You can make this game to play in golden time if you wish. Record what you have made in your homework book.</p>
